










Using suitable fixings, screw the base to surface, threading cable(s) through hole in process








Reattach lid and attach light to base using bolts, ensure cable is not trapped.



After sufficient testing of installation, power up supply and test further.

PIR SENSOR SET UP


The PIR (Passive Infra-Red) sensor has a sensing device which continuously scans a preset operating zone and immediately switches the lamp on when it detects movement in that area. To achieve the best results ideally the PIR sensor should be mounted 2m above the area to be scanned to avoid nuisance triggering, the sensor should be directed away from heat sources such as barbeques, air-con units, other outside lights, moving cars, and flue vents. Do not aim towards reflective areas such as white walls, swimming pools etc.



PIR CONTROLS


The PIR settings are two dials under the PIR sensor cover when the top semi-circle is twisted: **TIME:** The length of time that remains switched on after activation is adjustable from (10±5) seconds up to (10±1) minutes. Once the lamp has been triggered by the PIR sensor any subsequent detection will start the timed period again from the beginning.

LUX: The Lux control module has a built-in sensing device (PHOTODIODE) that detects daylight and darkness. Adjustable from daylight to night; it means that the lamp can be turned on after activation in daylight or night according to your setting.



PIR OVERRIDE

- 1. When the power is on, The PIR detector will be in a warmup mode for about one minute. After this minute the light will be in AUTO MODE
- During AUTO MODE, by switching the designated switch off and on within 3 seconds the light will then be in MANUAL MODE. In MANUAL MODE the light will not be affected by the PIR sensor.
- During MANUAL mode, switching the switch off and on within 3 seconds the light will change back to AUTO MODE
